

Drawing & Painting Program, Frequently Asked Questions

- What should I wear for class? We are an art studio; therefore, you should dress accordingly, especially if you are in our painting program. We do not suggest that you wear white clothing or dressy clothes with fluffy sleeves that are not easily able to be rolled up. Smocks are available for you to use but it is at the discretion of the student to get one and put it on.
- What do I need to bring to class each session? All students, both drawing & painting students should have a sketch book 9x12 or larger and bring it to each session. Sketch books can be purchased through our Amazon page, located on the drawing & painting registration page. Students are encouraged to doodle and draw at home and bring sketches to class!
- How do your sessions run? Is there a designated start and end date for your eight-week program? No, each student may start their sessions as soon as they register. Their eight-week program begins consecutively from the day we agree for you to start. You will receive an email close to the end of your eight sessions, reminding you to renew. Unfortunately, we cannot hold your spot/time unless you renew your session. *Failure to communicate with us or renew your program on time may affect your placement and spot within the program.
- What if we need to miss a session? Are their make-ups? Yes, absolutely! When you register, if you know at that time that you have a scheduled vacation, doctors' appointment, etc. please let us know. We can modify your scheduled sessions to accommodate that and we can offer you a make up option or add a session to the end of your program. **Please see our cancellation/no-show policy* for further information. Advanced notice is required.
- How young will you take a student for drawing and/or painting lessons? Our youngest student to date has been 4 ½ years old and go all the way through adulthood! We have a great "Littles" program that we are very proud of and have been working with students between the ages of 5 – 7 years old for a long time. They begin by working on their shapes, to build drawings, shading with colored pencils, brush control with paint and proportion so that they learn to draw objects in the appropriate size to the paper or canvas they are working with. We make learning the color wheel fun, blending colors and learning the primary and secondary colors and how NOT to make mud! LOL.
- Does your program run all year? What about during the summer and school vacations/closings? Our program is open all year long, with the exception of some holidays we are closed. * A list of our holiday/studio closings is available inside the studio. We understand that at various times of the year, your child may participate in other activities that may require their schedule to



flex. During those times and in the summer, we do our best to offer a few options for you to choose from so that your child can continue their program!
